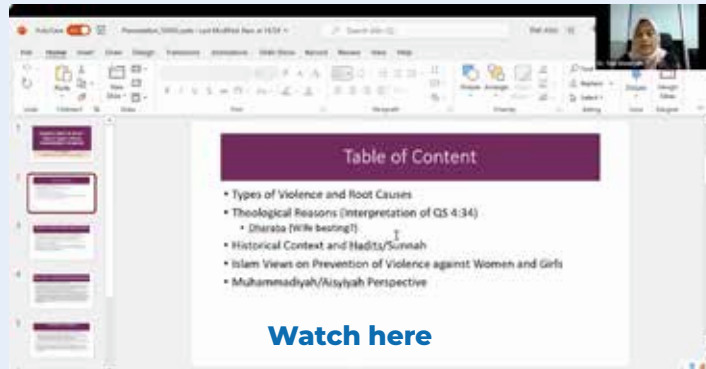

Women's Rights & Gender Justice

Preventing Violence Against Women and Girls in Islam — Dialogue 1

This recording is one of the most substantive pieces of content produced through the network's dialogue platforms. Bringing together scholars, practitioners and advocates, it explores how faith can be a powerful resource in addressing violence against women and girls. The discussion demonstrates how faith actors continue to engage with complex social issues while promoting dignity, justice and gender equality.



Peaceful, Just & Inclusive Communities

Interfaith Dialogue towards Sustainable Peace and Stable Livelihoods

In a context marked by conflict and fragility, faith actors from South Sudan demonstrate what is possible when communities choose dialogue over division. This short documentary highlights interfaith peacebuilding efforts led by Faith to Action Network members; the Evangelical Alliance of South Sudan (EASS) and Pan-African Christian Women Alliance (PACWA); and showcases the role of faith leaders in strengthening trust, social cohesion and peaceful coexistence.
